Downtown Leesburg Update: Main Street Milling and Resurfacing Nears Completion

LEESBURG, Fla – The City of Leesburg began milling and resurfacing Main Street from Canal Street to Orange Avenue in downtown last month. The next construction activity includes seal coating the parking stalls along Main Street. Weather permitting, crews will complete the seal coating during the next two weekends. The parking stalls along the road will be closed as follows:

- From 4 a.m., Sunday morning, July 16 until 7 a.m., Monday morning, July 17:
 - Parking stalls on the north side of Main Street from Canal Street to Orange Avenue will be closed.

- From 4 a.m., Sunday morning, July 23 until 7 a.m., Monday morning, July 24:
 - Parking stalls on the south side of Main Street from Canal Street to Orange Avenue will be closed.

Final striping is likely to be done in about four to six weeks, once the new asphalt has had time to cure.

The City's goal is to complete the roadwork quickly, efficiently, and with minimal disruption. Weather may affect the construction schedule.
