LEESBURG, Fla – City of Leesburg City Commissioners and the Carver Heights/Montclair Community Development Agency (CRA) Board will celebrate the ground breaking for the Leesburg Resource Center at 10:30 a.m. on May 11 at 3003 Schoolview Street, Leesburg. The public and local media are invited.

The Leesburg Resource Center is a multi-purpose facility that will include meeting rooms, computer-training space, a kitchen and café, resource offices, and a central meeting hall. Through partnerships with non-profit organizations, government agencies, churches and civic groups, the Center will provide a family-friendly and accessible place that offers services and activities to enhance education and employability skills of Leesburg residents.

Funding for the Leesburg Resource Center is from the City of Leesburg, Lake County, and the Carver Heights/Montclair CRA.
