Venetian Gardens Pool Closure

The City of Leesburg Venetian Gardens swimming pool is currently closed due to the need for unforeseen repairs and will remain closed at least through Sunday, June 7th. Over the years chlorine build up in pool lines has led to blockage and pipe corrosion, causing major leaks in the return plumbing system. The pool – one of the oldest municipal pools in Florida – was originally built in 1929 and enlarged in 1962.

The Leesburg Public Works and Recreation Departments are working diligently with the contractors, Beasley Underground Construction and Interpipe Solutions, to complete the work and re-open the swimming pool in a timely manner. In the meantime, residents are urged to utilize the H.O. Dabney Swimming Pool located at 1080 Beecher Street.
